## Graduation Ceremony Procession

Wednesday, June 22, 2022

- The SAS Graduation Ceremony will take place under tents, on the field, at the back of Salmon Arm Secondary school, overlooking Shuswap Lake. In the event there is rain, the ceremony will be moved into the school.
  - *Graduates and guests will be walking during the ceremony, and at times on grass.*
- Parking may be an issue and we highly recommend **carpooling**. There will be a drop-off location for those guests with mobility concerns.
- Graduates and guests are to arrive to the school **15 minutes** before their scheduled time.
- Graduates are to arrive wearing their graduation cap and gown.
  - *Grads who still need to pick up their cap and gown can go to the Art room exterior entrance.*
- Graduates and guests will walk to the marshalling area beside the gymnasium (lower parking lot).
  - *SAS staff members will help to line up and provide direction to graduates and guests.*
- There will not be a Live Stream of this event. If desired, families can record their child's ceremony using their own device.
- A SAS staff member will take photographs throughout the ceremony to capture moments of the day, but not necessarily photos of every single graduate. Families should plan to take their own photographs throughout the ceremony.
- Following the ceremony, graduates and guests will be invited up to the **Ceremony Viewing Section**. This area is reserved:
  - for additional photo opportunities,
  - to view other graduate ceremonies,
  - to enjoy food and beverages for purchase from local **food trucks** on location,
  - to hand back their graduation gown.
- The **Grad Class Group Photo** will take place at 5:30pm at the McGuire Lake Friendship Gate. Make sure to show up early.
- The **Dry-Grad Celebration** begins at 7:00pm at Salmon Arm Secondary. Graduates are to arrive by 7:30pm to be allowed into the event. Late graduates will not be permitted into the event.
